

GRASSROOTS MOMENTUM

Three Options to Coordinate Grassroots Momentum

Option 1) STAY THE SAME

We keep the same structures from pre-coup, as amended by the last Momentum National Committee meeting. That means:

- a. A co-ordinating group over see day to day work (currently 9 members)
- b. The National Committee meets at least quarterly.
- c. Regions meet on the same schedules as pre-coup.

Option 2) GRASSROOTS GROUP NETWORK

Local Groups meet as normal, but affiliate to Grassroots Momentum.

All affiliated groups send 2 reps to meet quarterly at a forum for networking and discussing good practice, perspectives, policy, campaigning priorities etc. (This replaces the current NC).

For day to day running the annual conference directly elects a Coordinating Group with specific roles/responsibilities as follows:

- 1) Chair
- 2) Secretary
- 3) Treasurer
- 4) Labour Party Specialism
- 5) Political Education
- 6) Local Group Liaison

They will meet regularly, i.e. weekly or fortnightly, and send a newsletter/update after each meeting to all affiliated groups. New positions can be co-opted if needed and agreed by the group forum.

Option 3) ONE NEW STEERING COMMITTEE

A steering committee of 15-20 people who meet six weekly. They can elect an executive if they wish. Regions meet on the same schedules as pre-coup.

In all cases, Grassroots Liberation Groups will network and build from the bottom up in a meaningful way. Liberation self organisation and self determination will strengthen our movement and do away with tokenism.
